CenterPoint Energy has constructed the Lantana Point Peak Shaving Facility (where they store 300,000 gallons of DANGEROUS liquid PROPANE GAS) in my neighborhood. This facility is located @

13617 Hillcroft, Houston, TX 77085.

LPG is a HIGHLY flammable gas.

We have seen how gas leaks & explosions from human error, etc. have caused extensive harm to communities locally & globally by causing injury, lose of property and lose of life. This facility is less than 500 feet from many of our backyards. We now experience sleepless nights realizing the danger we are in. What if a bullet or projectile struck the ABOVE ground LPG tanks. We would die a horrible death. My neighborhood would be no more. Again the holding tanks are above ground NOT buried & the street they sit on/Hillcroft is a major Houston street that is very busy. Also the facility is easily noticed...it is not hidden from terrorist or the insane. On Hillcroft less than 2 blocks away is a large school, KIPP, at the corner of Hillcroft & S. Main. These children are not safe with 300,000 gallons of LPG two blocks away.

Within 500 feet to the left of the CenterPoint tanks is Our Savior's Church. This congregation is very unhappy about this situation. They never received notice of this facility to be able to protest it being built next to the Church. They feel this is a potential bomb right next door.

Your Proposed Solution

I propose the CenterPoint facility be moved to a location away from this neighborhood & away from any subdivision. Southwest Crossing neighborhood changed for the worse when CenterPoint's holding facility moved here.

HOUSTON IS 52 MILES WIDE! There are areas that are less populated than this location. Areas where the 300,000 gallons of propane would be less of a threat to human life.property.

Again, I propose CenterPoint move.
